Pan Intercultural Arts is a charity harnessing the power of the arts to drive social change and integration. We work with refugees, survivors of trafficking, and young people from underserved communities, empowering them to rediscover their voices and shape brighter futures for themselves and society as a whole. Their mental health and wellbeing are at the core of our work.





A BRAND NEW SPACE FOR CREATIVITY, COMMUNITY & CONNECTION

In January 2026, Pan opened its first Arts Centre in Vauxhall, zone 1, just 5 minutes from the London Underground and mainline stations.

This is a multi-purpose, spacious, newly refurbished ground floor wing over 6,500 square feet in the centre of Vauxhall. We have a welcome area, kitchen, workshop space, green room, community area, art room, child space, quiet space and meeting room – all available to hire.

We have created a space which works for communities, organisations and individuals who seek space and connection – and we're always on the lookout to partner with likeminded people, particularly in the creative and charity sectors.

We offer a range of versatile and inspiring spaces for hire, as well as facilitating corporate workshops and private dining experiences. Our venue is adaptable and every discussion for hire packages will be made bespoke to your needs. Whether it's a takeover of the whole centre, hosting a creative workshop, an inspiring venue tour and more, we'd love for you to join us in helping the Pan Centre flourish now and for future generations.





THE WELCOME AREA

As you enter our Pan Centre you enter our Welcome Area, featuring a 5.5m long table which can easily seat 20, a sofa, soft seating and a space for flexible working. The space includes a projector onto one of the clear walls.

Both the Pan office and kitchen are an extension of this room.

This can be used for private dining, meetings, gatherings, talks or as a welcome point if you're hiring the whole space.

Hire this space from £75 per hour.





WORKSHOP SPACE

This is our largest room where we run our weekly projects. It can be used for rehearsals, performances, events and talks.

- Up to 100 seated and/or standing
- Recommended up to 30 for workshops & classes
- White wall or pull down screen for any projection use
- Connected to a Green Room which is included in hire fee
- 70 x stackable chairs available

Hire this space from £75 per hour.





COMMUNITY SPACE

Our open area is as adaptable as it is welcoming! Can be used for community events, talks and gatherings.

There is significant wall space which can be used for exhibition and display.

As you enter the room, we have an artist commission, reimagining Pan's 40 year history as a colourful river.

- Up to 80 seated and/or standing
- If standing, sofa and soft seating arrangements available
- Additional moveable wallspace and plinths for exhibitions available
- Open space

MESSY ROOM & CHARITY OFFICE

Our room where mess is encouraged!

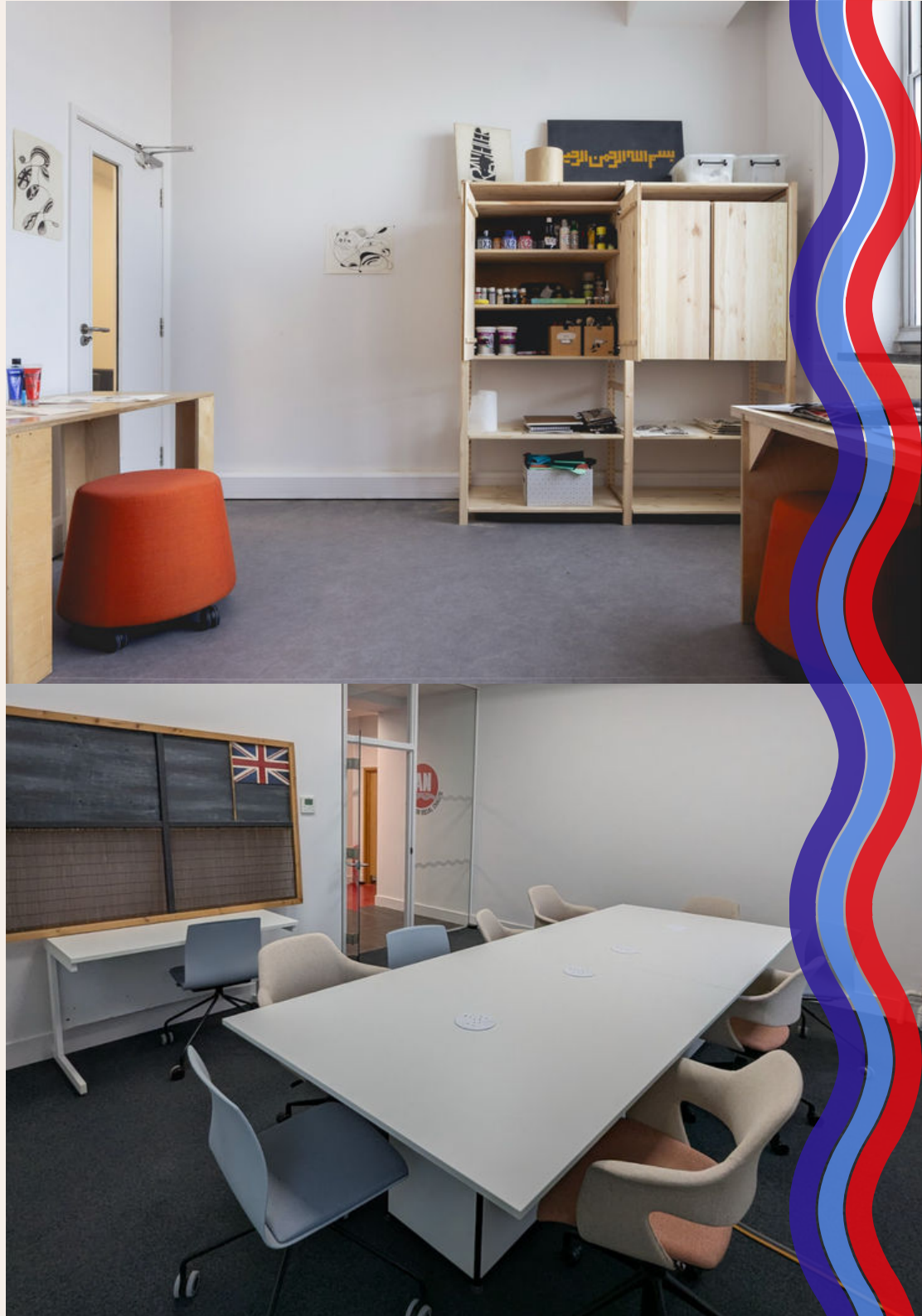
This space is perfect for art classes and making workshops.

Up to 20 seated round an art table.

Hire this space from £60 per hour.

HOT DESKING AT PAN

We also offer a relaxed and welcoming workspace for charities, social enterprises, and creatives to work alongside one another in a spacious community arts centre with great facilities.

Join our tight knit community of creatives using the space knowing that your investment is fuelling arts for social change.

We have up to 8 desks available Mon - Thu from 10am - 6pm with prices starting from £15.

Includes:

- Unlimited wifi use
- Unlimited hot drinks for £5 per day
- Use of our 'Quiet Space' for private meetings
- Use of our welcome area and community space if a change of scenery is needed!





ACCOMPANYING ROOMS

Kitchen

With a dishwasher, fridge/freezer, oven, hob, microwave and kettle. It can be used as part of your hire for a small additional fee.

Quiet Space

This space is included within your hire and is for any moments where you need room to breathe and to have some privacy.

Children's Room

This space (first picture) can be hired for children's use and has a selection of books, toys and crafts available. Baby changing facilities available.

Meeting Room

Can seat up to 12 round a large table (until it is hired longer term).

Green Room

Included in the hire fee for the workshop area - this can be used as a small breakout space and also for performances - there are doors into the workshop space and main area.

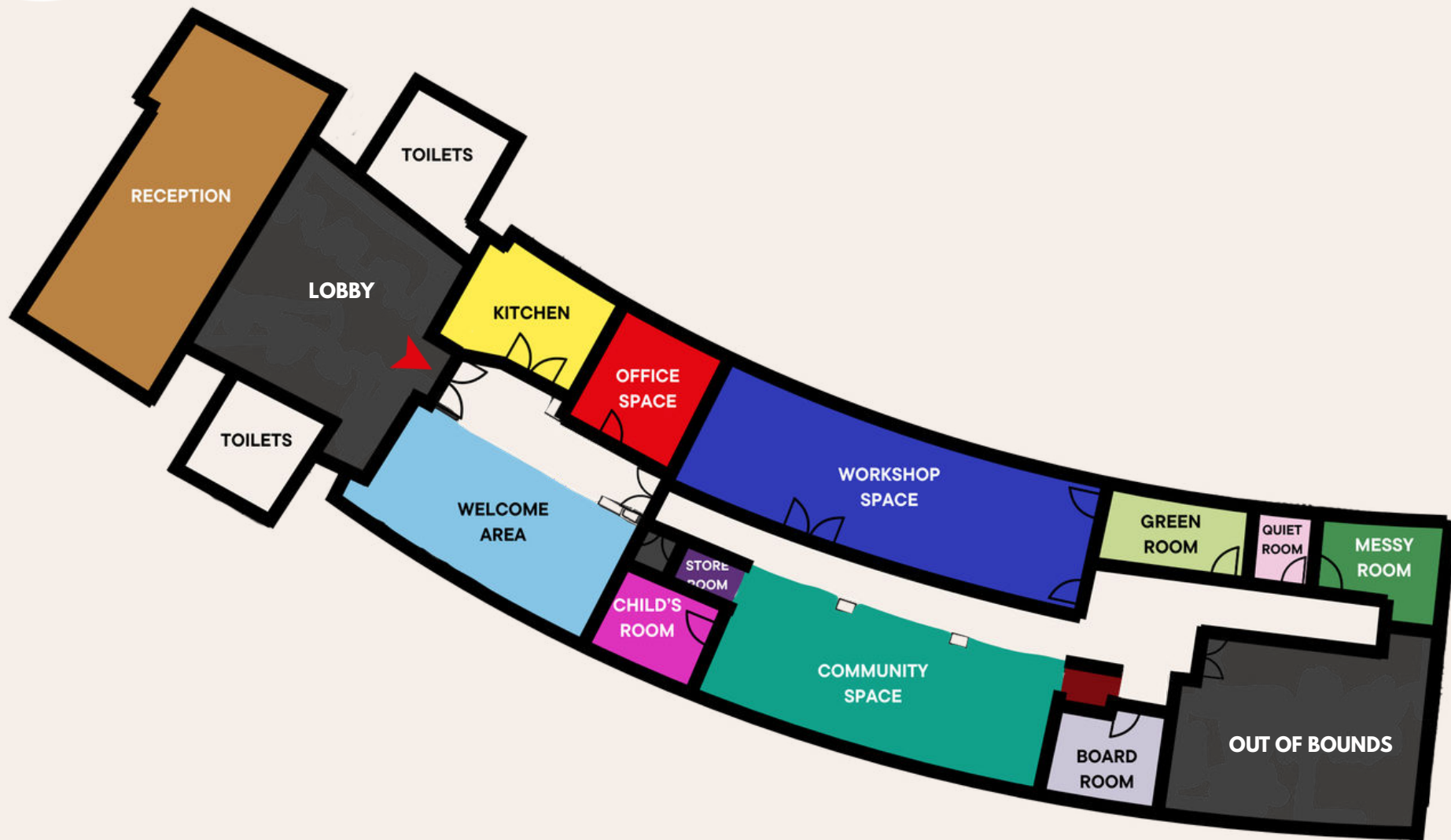

ABOUT PAN

Our participants are at the heart of everything we do.

We work with groups of people who are often not heard in society, those who may feel lost, uprooted, anxious and unsafe. Our aim is to give them opportunities to build their self confidence and develop their sense of self worth. We work with people from all cultures and religions to encourage a world where we listen to, understand and respect each other's lives and experiences, discovering the possibilities of our rich society.

Not only do their ideas, views and needs steer all our activities, the majority of our artist-facilitators were once participants in our projects and bring vital lived experience into the work.

In the year **September 2024 to August 2025** we achieved:

- ➡ **374** WORKSHOPS
- ➡ **615** PARTICIPANTS
- ➡ **11** ONGOING PROJECTS
- ➡ **8488** PARTICIPANT HOURS





WHY PAN'S WORK IS NEEDED

Trauma limits more than opportunity — it limits imagination. When someone has lived in survival mode, it becomes almost impossible to picture a different future: a job, an education, a life filled with hope and possibility. Pan exists to reignite that imagination.

Through the arts, we help people move beyond experiences of trauma to rebuild confidence, reclaim their voice, and rediscover their potential. As one participant put it, **“I was broken in pieces — now I can stand on my own feet.”**

Pan works with people whose lives have been shaped by complex and overlapping challenges — from displacement and discrimination to poverty and poor mental health. 94% of our participants identify as Black, South Asian, Middle Eastern, East or Southeast Asian, or Mixed heritage. Each person's story is unique, and our approach is rooted in meeting them where they are, using creativity as a tool for healing, empowerment, and social change.

Employability becomes a natural outcome of this process: many progress into education, training, or full-time work, and over 85% of our paid artist-facilitators are former participants themselves.

By transforming trauma into creativity and isolation into community, Pan creates lasting personal and social change — unlocking potential that benefits individuals, communities, and society as a whole.

Whether you are hiring for an event, running a rehearsal or using our hot desks, you know that your investment is going straight into supporting those who need it the most.
